- Ensure that your son/daughter attends school regularly, and notify the school when he/she is unable to attend.
- Keep your son/daughter at home when unwell.
- Maintain contact with staff through the home/school diary, email, telephone and visits to the school.
- Inform the school of anything that may influence your son's / daughter's behaviours at school.
- Attend EHCP Review meetings and parent Consultation Evenings.
- Support, where possible the school events and activities.

We as a school will aim to:

- Provide a safe, secure environment where all pupils feel safe, are happy and motivated to learn.
- Offer a curriculum that is rich and varied, that provides stimulation and challenge.
- Provide opportunities for pupils to grow in confidence and independence.
- Promote a happy, friendly atmosphere, where all achievements however small are celebrated, where praise, encouragement and respect for others are the norm.
- Ensure that parents and carers are kept informed of their son's / daughter's progress.
- Offer regular opportunities to discuss pupil progress, experiences and parental concerns.
- Work with all other agencies such as health and social services to encourage integrated support for the pupils.

Pupils will aim to:

- Try to do their best and work hard.
- Be kind to everyone.
- Behave in a way which respects other pupils, members of staff and the school building.
- Follow their individual class rules.
